## NUMBERS

- Numbers will be available at the secretary booth
- Numbers must be worn on rider's backs
- Numbers should be returned at the end of each show

## PRIZES

Ribbons from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place

Champion and Reserve Champion for each Hunter division and Dressage division.

1<sup>st</sup> place= 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place= 4 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place= 3 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place=2 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place= 1 point.

## YEAR END AWARDS

There will be award ceremonies throughout the day at the last show of the year, for each division.

The top 3 riders will receive awards.

## CHALLENGE POINTS FOR YEAR END AWARDS

1<sup>st</sup> place= 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place= 4 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place= 3 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place=2 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place= 1 point.

TOTAL = Placing points x # of entries in class

## INFORMATION

- It is recommended to enter **one entire Dressage Division** and **one entire Hunter Division**. This will make you eligible for day end awards!
- Entries must be received two Wednesdays prior to the show. Late entries will be accepted however a late fee will apply. Entry fees must accompany the entry forms. No refunds at any time!
- Entry form, Rider Liability form, Owner Liability Form, & fees must be received 11 days before each show.
- Forms are now available on line, on our web site [www.riverviewstables.ca](http://www.riverviewstables.ca)
- E-transfer should be sent to [janet@riverviewstables.ca](mailto:janet@riverviewstables.ca) Without full payment, entry will be considered late, and late fees will apply.
- A FEE of \$30.00, will be charged for cheques that are returned from the bank for any reason.
- SCRATCH FEE: Should a cancellation be necessary, refunds will be given if notification is received before the riding times have been posted \$35.00 or, between posting and 4:00pm the day before the show \$50.00. (entries paid, less the scratch fee)
- There are no refunds for "no shows".
- Divisions may be split or combined at show secretary's discretion
- All distances will be on a 12' stride. Riders will not be penalized for adding a stride.
- Refusals in the hunter ring, 2 = Elimination.
- Memberships 1. Ontario Equestrian Both owners & riders must be current members of OE. Photocopies of membership must accompany entries. For more information go to [ontarioequestrian.ca](http://ontarioequestrian.ca)
- Acceptance of Risk: Neither Riverview Stables, its volunteers, show organizers, helpers, staff members, or their families shall in any way be held responsible for any accident, injury, death, damage or loss of property of any competitor or visitor to show sites. An Acceptance of Risk form must be signed by each competitor and horse owner.
- Commonly accepted practices in each discipline will govern. Inquire with show secretary if you have questions. Note, some modifications may be made to allow for the inexperience of some competitors.
- A copy of a current year negative Coggins Test for each horse must accompany entries.
- Every person mounted on a horse must wear an ASTM approved riding helmet properly fastened at all times when they are mounted on a horse, as well as proper riding footwear.
- Riders must wear their numbers at all times while riding.
- No Dogs please.
- Hors Concours will be accepted.
