TIMES

Students should arrive 1 hour before each schedule. Shows rarely run-on time. Come early to avoid missing your class. Classes will not wait for absent riders.

Show times will be e-mailed out the day before the show

NUMBERS

- Numbers will be available at the canteen during turnout
- Numbers must be worn on rider's backs
- Numbers should be returned at the end of each show

PRIZES

Ribbons from 1st to 6th place at the end of each class

Champion and Reserve Champion for each Hunter division and Dressage division.

Top Rider Trophy and Ribbons for Points totaled from all three shows at the end of the final Fall show

ATTIRE

- For riding you should wear beige or gray riding pants (dark is fine if you don't have a light pair), a riding blouse (or shirt with a raised neck), and a dark show jacket (solid dark sweater or sweatshirt). Riding boots, dark gloves, and certified helmets are mandatory. As weather gets colder riders will not be penalized for warmer coats. Come dressed for the days weather.

ENTRIES

- It is recommended to enter **ONE Entire Dressage Division** and **ONE Entire Hunter Division**. This will make you eligible for day end awards!
- Entries must be received one week prior to the show. Late entries will be accepted however a late fee will apply. Entry fees must accompany the entry forms. No refunds at any time!
- The show secretary has the right to move students into a more appropriate class if the class is not suitable for the rider. The level suitable for each student may vary depending on the entries at each show!

REMEMBER

- Our Canteen will be available
- All entry forms and payments must be sent by e-mail
- The horse will not be judged. It is the rider's position and execution of transitions that will be judged. The rider will not be penalized for a horse's actions unless it is the rider who has done something to create the situation.
- When competing at a show you should enter in a level lower than what you are schooling. Our shows give students the opportunity to show what they already know.
- If you have a questions / problems ask an instructor (not a student or the judge).
- **HAVE FUN!!!**
- Whether or not you win, remember that you are here because you love riding. Only one person will get the first place ribbon, but everyone who tries his or her best is a winner!

AGREEMENT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF RISK & WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I understand that the sport of horses is a high-risk sport & that I am participating at my own risk & in full knowledge that there is some element of risk that an accident could occur & result in injury or death to the rider or mount.

In consideration of acceptance of this entry or my being permitted to take part in the event, I agree to save harmless & keep indemnified Riverview Stables Inc. Show organizers, & their respective agents, officials, servants & representatives from & against all claims, actions, cost and expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to any person or property however caused, arising out of or in connection with my taking part in this event & notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by negligence of Janet Borse, their agents, official, servants or representatives. It is understood & agreed that the agreement is to be binding on myself, my heirs & assigns.

Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted. Approved headgear meets ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) standards & displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk & that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I accept this risk & hold harmless the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees & representatives.

I understand that while participating in this high-risk sport, it is recommended that I wear a helmet with a fixed harness while mounted. By not wearing proper safety headgear, I fully accept all responsibilities of my actions.
